KEYNOTE SPEAKERS BIOGRAPHIES

PANTHEO FOUNDATION KEYNOTE LECTURE

Guest Speaker: Professor Kypros Nicolaides, FRCOG

Professor of Fetal Medicine, King's College Hospital, London, UK



Professor Kypros Nicolaides is the founder and chairman of the of The Fetal Medicine Foundation (FMF) which he set up in 1995. He is one of the pioneers of fetal medicine. His discoveries have revolutionized fetal medicine. He introduced the screening of chromosomal and structural abnormalities, has improved the screening and prevention of pre-eclampsia and premature birth and allowed the development of fetal therapy. He is the author of more than a thousand peer-reviewed scientific articles and more than 30 books and monographs. He has an H-index of 183, which is the highest of any Obstetrician & Gynaecologist in the world, and has had his research cited over 135,000 times.

He is currently the director of the fetal medicine unit at the King's College Hospital in London, recognized as the largest fetal medicine unit in the world, where dozens of doctors come yearly from all around the world for training.

He has recently proposed a new model of pregnancy care — "Turning the Pyramid of Prenatal Care". This aims to assess the risk for most of the relevant pregnancy complications affecting mother and unborn child during a hospital visit at 11-13 weeks of gestation and, on the basis of such risks, provide personalized care to reduce an adverse outcome.

Sofia Theodoropoulou, MD, PhD, FRCOphth is a graduate of Athens Medical School and has been full trained in Surgical Ophthalmology in United Kingdom (Cambridge, Bristol). She is a member of Royal College of Ophthalmologists, UK, while she has performed a fellowship in MEEI, Harvard Medical School, and also completed a PhD in Ophthalmology.

She has been Associate Professor (Senior Lecturer) in University of Bristol and consultant ophthalmologist at NHS. She has received numerous awards and grants, including the Global Ophthalmology Award from Bayer (2017) for her contribution in treatment in retinal diseases and a grant from the Academy of Medical Sciences for Immunotherapy for macular degeneration (2016). She has numerous publications and presentation in international conferences, with over 800 citations.

Since 2022, she is consultant ophthalmologist at Hygeia Hospital, Athens, Greece.
